The Boston Home Adds New Officers to Board of Trustees

Dorchester, Mass—The Boston Home (TBH) in Dorchester recently announced the following elections to its Board of Trustees: Holly Burnes, RN, MS, CS, as president; Karen Quigley as vice president; John Hannon as treasurer; and Debra Frankel as clerk. Burnes, a nurse and mind-body psychotherapist in private practice in Chestnut Hill succeeds John Woodard of Dedham, who was TBH board president since 1985. Woodard continues as a trustee.

The Boston Home is an 84-bed, not-for-profit, long-term-care facility for adults with disabilities—predominantly multiple sclerosis. It is the only facility of its kind in New England and one of three in the United States.
